## 13<sup>th</sup> January 1985 Taylor's Level

Following a shortened C.O.M.R.U. meet nearby several members decided to push a little further in Taylor's Level. It was decided to go down the stope, through the collapsed floor at point \* on the previous plan. Dennis Webb was first down having first placed a bolt belay and a deviation belay about 20' down. The pitch proved to be 85' and landed on the roof of a level which was broached nearby. This proved to be Deep Level and the point at which C.A.T. had penetrated to 'Cobblers Hole' the previous May was seen. Also Deep Level could be followed to the sump down to water level. This represents a much easier route down to continue any digs.
