GRADING SYSTEM

- E. -Easy: Level walking, scrambling on easy ground, no SRT or ladders. D. -Difficult: Involves abseils or ladder pitches and awkward ground. Short prussick pitches may be included, in which case the meet will be designated SRT.
- S. Severe: Long or awkward SRT pitches, false floors, unstable ground. EXP. Exploratory. These meets are intended to explore unknown ground. Long abseil and prussick pitches, rope traverses, deep water, or unstable ground may be expected, and participants should therefore be fully self sufficient in SRT and be able to exercise their own judgement.

Mine exploration is a potentially hazardous activity, and members and guests participate at their own risk. Advice and guidance will be available at all meets except those graded EXP, but individuals are responsible in deciding at which grades they should participate. Do not hesitate to contact the Meet Leader or the Meets Secretary in advance for advice or information.
