#### GRADING SYSTEM

E - Easy. Level Walking, scrambling on easy ground, no SRT or ladders.
D - Difficult. Abseil or ladder pitches and awkward ground. Short prussicking pitches may be included, in which case the meet will be designated D,SRT.
S - Severe (or serious) Long or awkward SRT pitches, false floors and unstable ground may be encountered.

EXP- Exploratory. These meets are intended to push into unknown ground where long and difficult abseil and prussick pitches, rope traverses or deep water might be expected. Participants should be fully self sufficient in SRT and able to exercise their own judgement in all circumstances.
